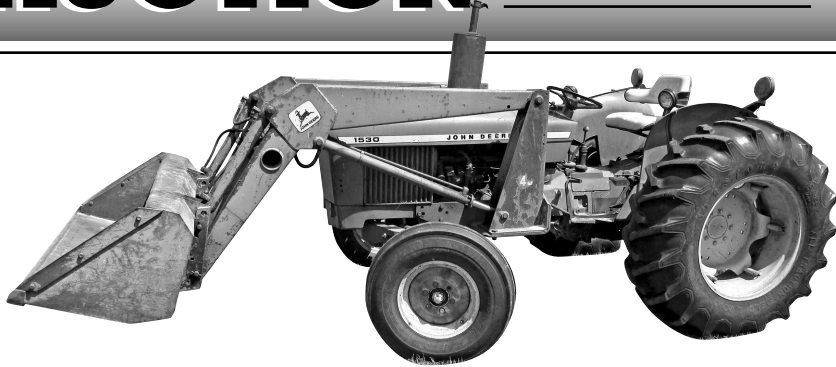

DIRECTIONS: Take US-131 north of Grand Rapids 23 miles or south of Big Rapids 29 miles to the Sand Lake exit #110, (22 Mile Road), East 2 miles to Federal (Old 131), North 2 miles to Stanton Rd., East 10 miles to Johnson Rd., North ½ mile to Willard Rd., East to the farm.
OR take M-91 North of Greenville 9 miles to Stanton Rd., West 3 miles to Johnson Rd., North ½ mile to Willard Rd. then east to the farm. (Montcalm Co.)
