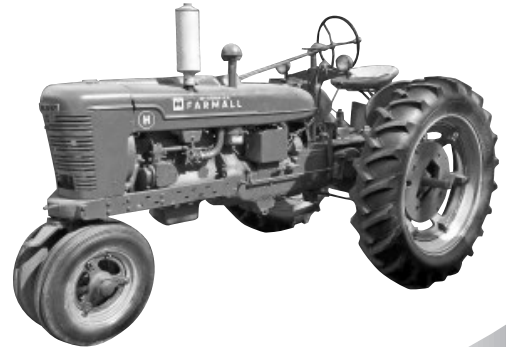
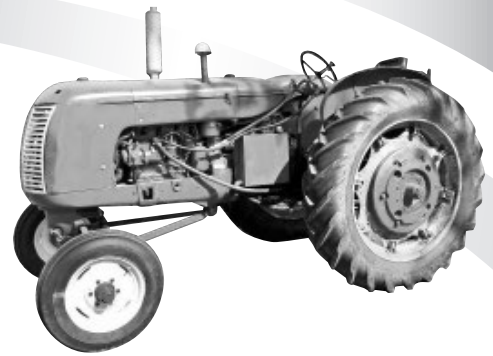

Watch for AUCTION signs. (Mecosta Co.)

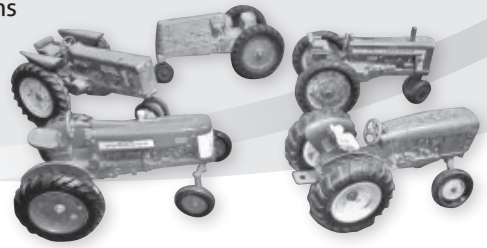
